

1. Our School

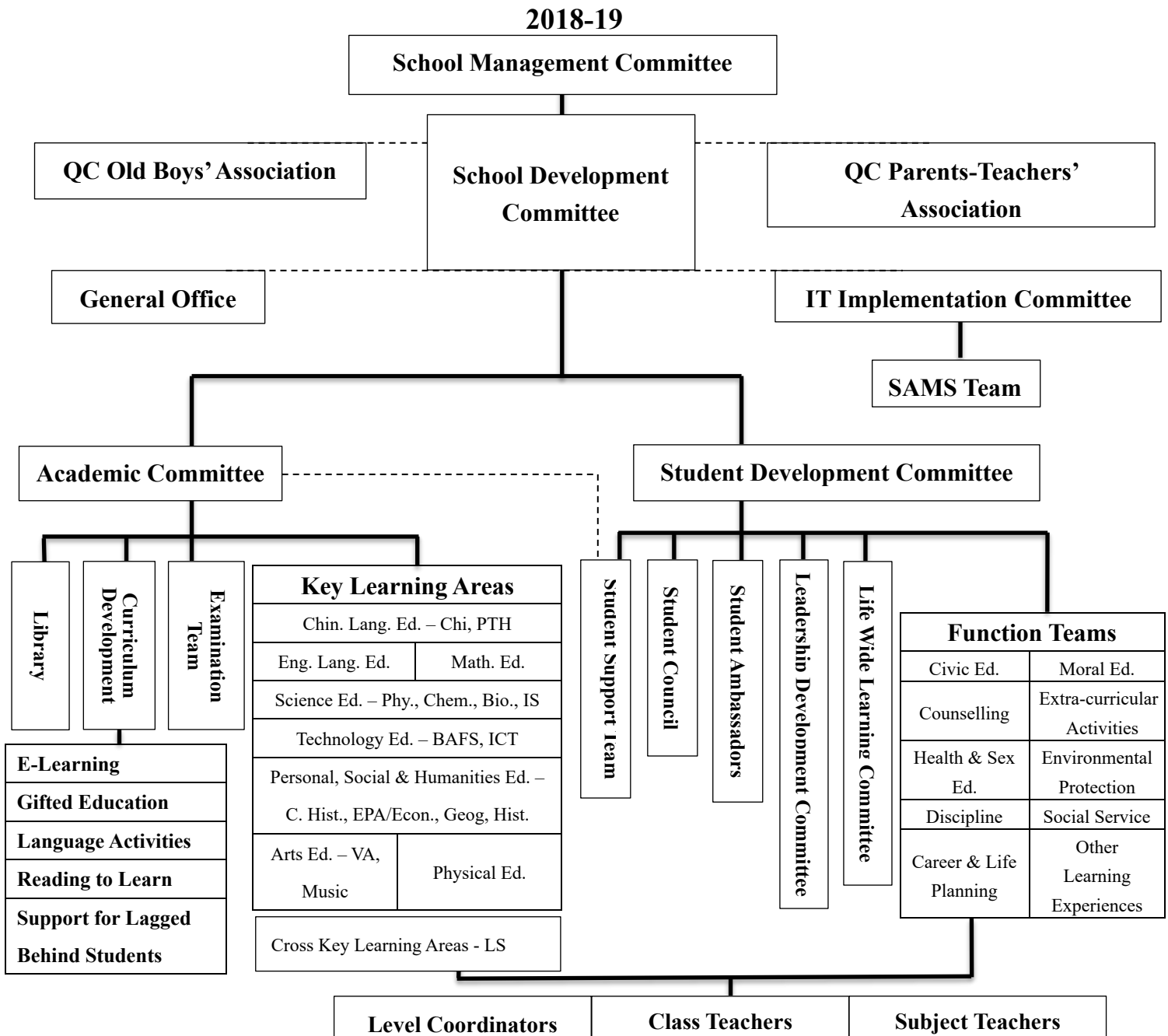
1.1 Brief History

The Government Central School was founded in 1862 at Gough Street, Central, as the first government school for boys. In 1889, it was moved to Aberdeen Street in the Central District, and its name was changed to Victoria College. In 1894, the school was renamed “Queen’s College”. After World War II, the school was re-opened at Kennedy Road. In 1950, Queen’s College was relocated to Causeway Road, its present site, and since then Queen’s College has been a whole-day secondary school for boys.

1.2 School Building

There are altogether 29 Classrooms, 5 Science Laboratories, 2 Computer Rooms, 3 e-learning Centers, Campus Wi-fi and Internet, 1 Lecture Room, 1 Meeting Room, 1 History Gallery, 1 Visual Arts Room, 1 Music Room, 1 Library, 1 Discipline and Counselling Room, 1 Social Worker’s Room and 1 Interview Room. The multi-purpose School Hall is on the ground floor. For recreation and outdoor activities, there are 2 Playgrounds, 1 School Garden (Morning Sun Corner), 1 Gymnasium and 1 Student Activity Centre.

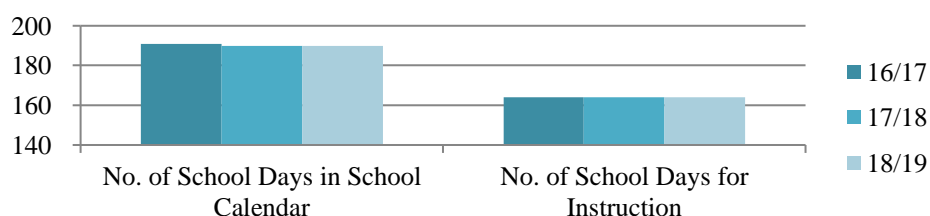

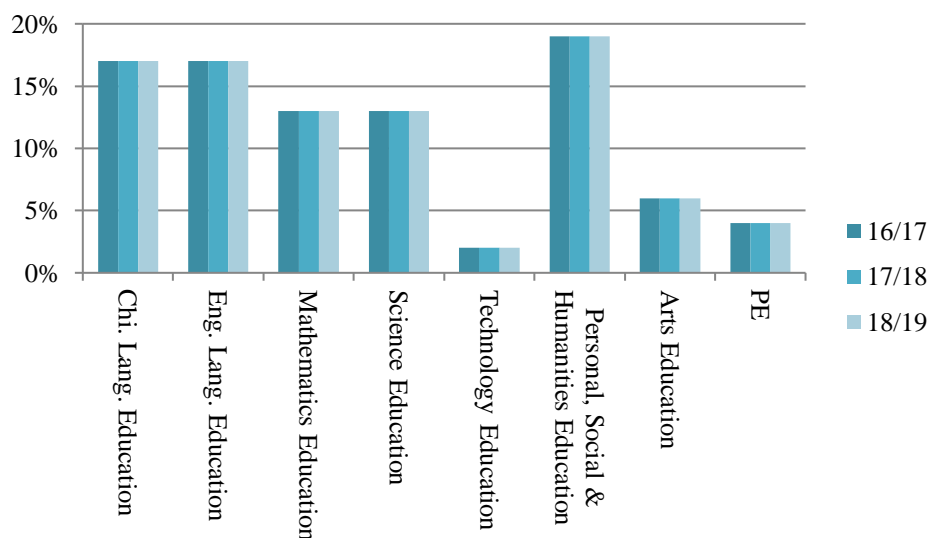

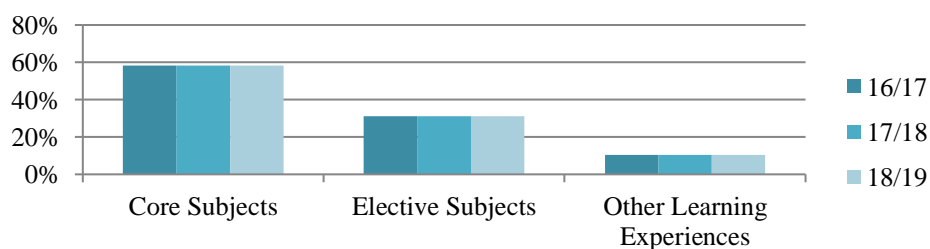
1.5 Number of Active School Days

2. Areas of Major Concern: Achievements & Reflections

Task 1: Promoting deep learning through experiential learning

Aims

To promote deep learning, subject departments designed and planned a wide variety of experiential learning activities inside and outside classrooms. Through the activities, students developed good learning skills. To develop the spirit of exploration and innovation, STEM education was implemented in different subject areas / KLAs.

Achievement

Experiential learning is the process of learning through the experience. It emphasizes on “learning by doing.” To promote deep learning through experiential learning, our school organized three training workshops and one talk for our teachers in this school year. All the workshops or talk aimed to introduce this learning strategy to facilitate the learning and teaching process. All subject departments planned at least one experiential learning activity in their curricula, including visits, field trips, mini-projects, competitions and scientific experiments. All the experiential learning activities were successfully held and the details of the activities were uploaded to the school server so that the experiences could be shared among teachers. Most of the teachers were satisfied with the training since they could master the basic skills in conducting experiential learning activities.

To foster a good reading habit, an e-library was set-up in the e-Class platform. 40 English books and 100 Chinese books were installed on the platform. Teachers, parents and students can read all the books using their mobile phones, tablets or computers. Besides, Morning Reading Scheme was implemented to develop students’ reading habits. All S1 and S2 students would read during the reading session on every Monday and Wednesday; we hoped that this scheme could provide an opportunity for students to read and initiate their interest in reading.

To develop the spirit of exploration and innovation, various STEM activities were held. Students joined various inter-school contests, and with the guidance of teachers and their efforts in doing research, they had the chance to join International Competitions such as Odyssey of the Mind 2019 World Finals in the University of Michigan, USA and 2019 World GreenMech Contest in Taiwan.

Reflection

Through experiential learning, students showed a great interest in learning. They grasped different generic skills in the activities. The nature of experiential learning engaged the students’ personal emotions and enhanced their knowledge and skills. When students see their work, they experienced greater pleasure and pride, thus enhanced their enthusiasm for continuous learning.

Task 2: To empower students with good qualities of empathy, respect and commitment so as to face the challenges in the future

Aims

To provide a learning environment and experience for students in promoting positive values and attitudes. To strengthen students' bonding with others in family, school and community. To further enhance and sustain students' sense of commitment to their respective roles so as to enable them to become contributing members to their families, schools and community. To develop teachers' professionalism in empowering students with good qualities of empathy, respect and commitment so as to face the challenges in the future.

Achievement

To provide a learning environment and experience for students in promoting positive values and attitude, co-ordination with subject departments and functional teams on their work progress in their curricula/plans. Surveys conducted at regular intervals show that the majority of subjects and teams have incorporated the related values in their curriculum/programmes. Students have responded with enthusiasm and positive reflection in the lessons/programmes conducted. Good collaboration with encouraging results among subjects/teams was observed (e.g. Humanities and Moral Education Team).

To strengthen students' bonding with others in family, school and community, a school-based formal values education curriculum with experiential learning activities in Liberal Studies for S.1 was implemented. The majority of students showed a better understanding of responsibility and other values from their reflection.

To further enhance and sustain students' sense of commitment to their respective roles so as to enable them to become contributing members to their families, schools and community, talks, workshops or personal growth programs for students from S.1 to S.5 with the objective of instilling positive values and attitudes into the minds of our students were organised. Multifarious activities/programmes have been organized for all levels with positive feedback from participants. For most of the programmes conducted, students' responsibility and commitment can be observed.

To develop teachers' professionalism in empowering students with good qualities of empathy, respect and commitment so as to face the challenges in the future All teachers encouraged to take part in professional training on understanding and promoting positive values and cultures, creating supportive school atmosphere, reinforcing and sustaining students' sense of commitment 83% of teachers agreed that the training could help strengthen the support for students' needs. Teachers to share their school-based experiences in Staff Meetings and Staff Development Days. Teachers were invited to share their experiences on formal and informal occasions.

Reflection

Overall, it was encouraging to observe that some of the strategies adopted this year yielded positive effects, creating positive impacts on students' attitude and behaviour on the values promoted.

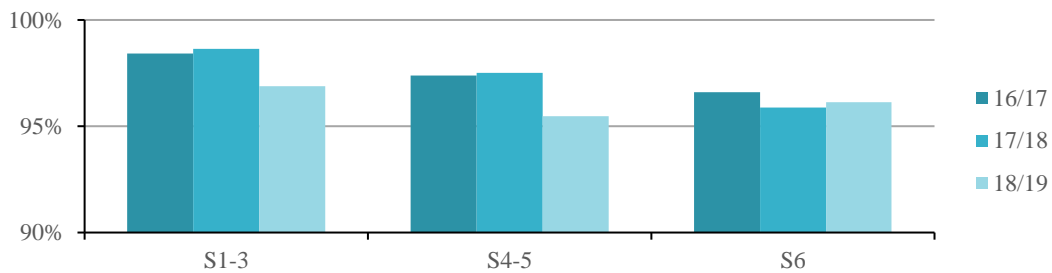

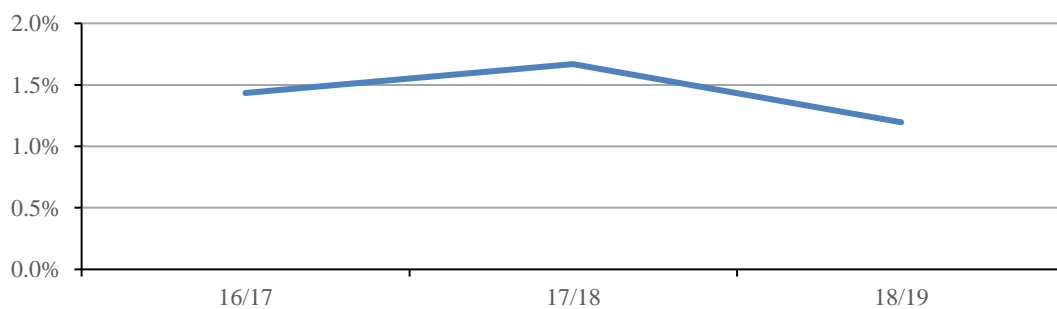

3.3 Students' Early Exit



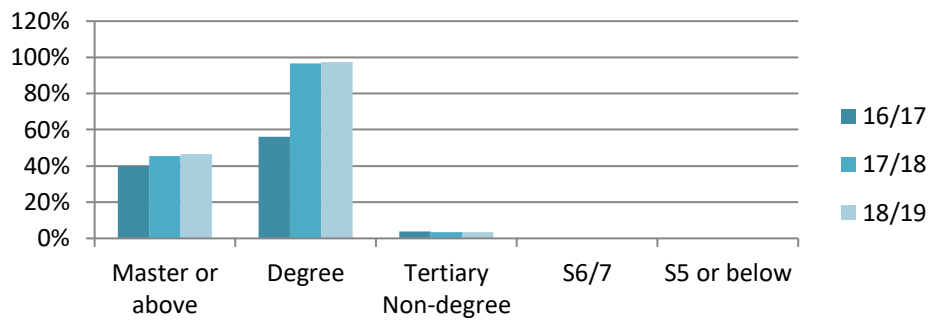

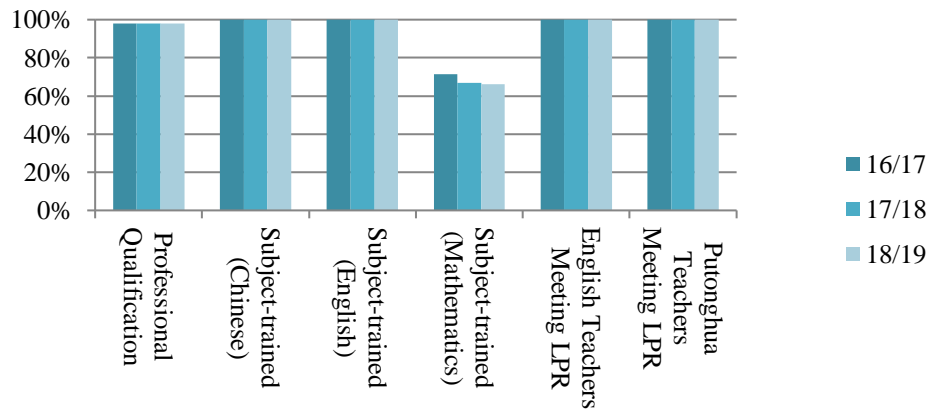

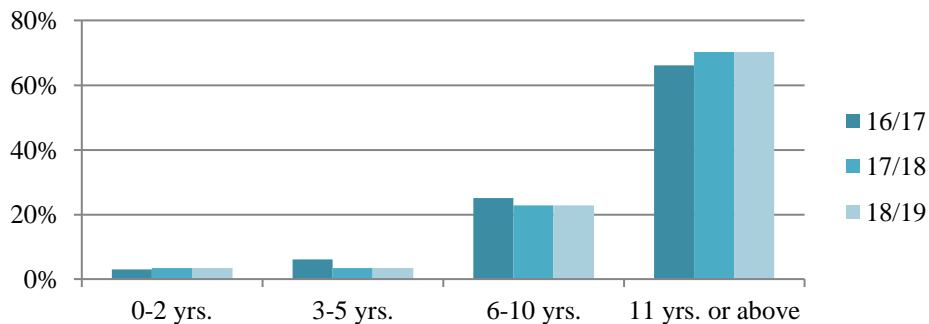
Academic Qualification



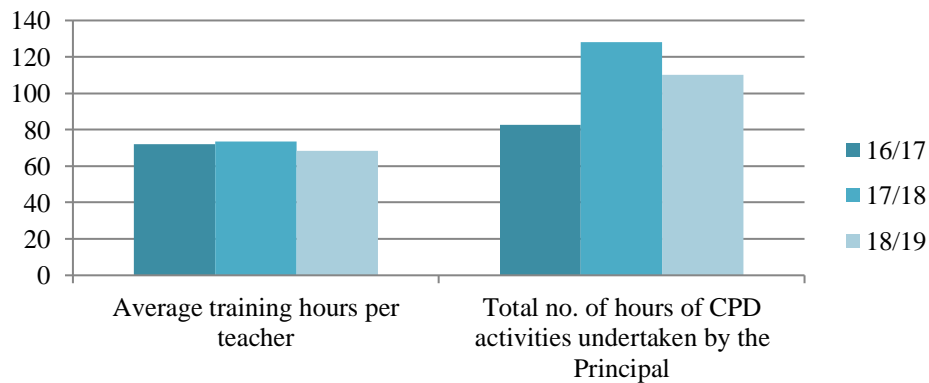
Professional Qualifications

In 2018-19, our school joined the 24th Teacher Commendation Scheme organized by the Committee on Respect Our Teachers Campaign: Ms. NGAI Pui-wah, Mr. CHIU Sin- hang, Mr. YU Wai-keung, Mr. LEUNG Ho-ting, Mr. CHUNG Mau-yin, Ms. KONG Suk-yea, Ms. CHIU Ming-sze, Mr. LAW Chi-keung and Mr. CHAN Yuk-lun, were elected by students and teachers for commendation. Ms. NGAI Pui-wah and Mr. CHIU Sin- hang were also recommended for the Award of Commendation Certificates.

4. Support for Student Development

On top of facilitating students' academic pursuits, our school endeavours to foster whole-person development of students. In 2018-19, various function teams made concerted efforts to nurture our students to become valued members of our society.

The Counselling Team launched comprehensive remedial and developmental programs to facilitate students' personal growth. The Peer Guidance Scheme was effective in creating a strong sense of brotherhood and a caring atmosphere in school. In the Scheme, Peer Counsellors and Counselling Prefects played an important role as big brothers for their S1 and S2 schoolmates. The S1 Orientation Day and Orientation Camp, S1 Subject Talks, S1 Orienteering Competition, S2 HIPP Camp and other inter-level activities helped the younger brothers adapt more easily to life in secondary school and develop positive belief and attitude. The Counselling Team teachers also encouraged the big brothers to act as the role models of their young brothers and develop themselves on character building. Moreover, the school-based Life-wide Learning Periods, Adventure-ship Partnership Programme, Training on Emotional Management, Adventure-based Counselling Training and Visit to Life Journey Centre were also effective in nurturing respectful and responsible manners as well as positive beliefs when facing adversity among senior form students.

The Discipline Team held three prefect training workshops for S3 and S4 prefects in September and October, 2018 and June, 2019. The workshops aimed at teaching students the importance of cooperation and strengthening team spirit among discipline prefects. It was also hoped that the prefects could develop a positive attitude towards embracing challenges in the future. In the workshops, participating prefects made good efforts to achieve the goals. In the evaluation session, a number of participants stated that they had learnt a lot about working with others and tackling complicated problems which might arise when they perform their duties.

The Moral Education Team promoted the importance of moral values to students and helped them develop proper virtues and conduct. The team organized a variety of programmes and activities in 2018-19. The Promoting Moral Values through Reading Scheme was effective in creating an atmosphere of mutual appreciation among students, helping them develop proper values and a positive attitude towards life. The Edifying Reading Scheme helped students reflect on their behaviour. Life-wide Learning periods and a number of competitions were also held to help students establish good habits and proper moral values.

To broaden our students' horizons, enhance their understanding of our motherland, and nurture their sense of global citizenship, the Civic Education Team has held a series of activities including, Celebrity Talk, Almaty Cultural Study Tour, the Cultural Week, and Inter-class News and Basic Law Competitions.

The Career and Life Planning Team (CLP) issued regular publications and held a wide range of talks on subject choices, study skills and JUPAS applications for students and their parents so as to help students to make informed choices for their future. There were also workshops on writing university application statements and briefing sessions on overseas studies and scholarship applications. CLP workplace visits

were organized for Secondary 2 and 3 students to explore different careers in real settings. On 17 May 2019, the Team organized Career Expo with the Queen's College Old Boys' Association for senior form students. Old boys also provided job shadowing and internship programmes on fields of legal, accounting, civil engineering and property management for Secondary 5 and 6 students during the summer vacation. Furthermore, through the Mentorship Programme, the team hopes to help students broaden their perspectives, develop their potential and achieve their academic and career aspirations. Before and after the DSE results were released, a series of individual and group counselling sessions on further education opportunities were provided to S6 students and their parents.

Financed by the Beat Drugs Fund, the Health and Sex Education Team has been implementing the Healthy School Programme with a focus on discouraging drug use since 2011. The team continued to work with the Tung Wah Group of Hospitals CROSS Centre to organize a range of activities, together with our school-based programmes, to help students think positively, establish healthy lifestyles and develop positive values.

The Student Support Team continued to provide individual support to students with special educational needs (SEN). The School-based Educational Psychologist visited our school twice a month to conduct assessments of SEN cases, hold meetings with students, teachers and parents and offer advice on enhancing learning and teaching of SEN students. The SEN Teaching Assistant offered intensive everyday assistance to students with special physical or emotional needs. A series of individual or group intervention programmes for students with Autism Spectrum and/ or Attention-Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorders were conducted by Educational Psychologists or Behavioral Consultants. With the Learning Support Grant for Secondary Schools provided by the EDB, programmes were implemented to promote inclusive education.

To enhance students' environmental awareness, many activities were held in 2018-2019. They were Green Week, Conservation exhibition and games, Red packets recycling scheme, Inter-Class Waste Paper Competition, S1 Inter-Class Environmental Science Competition, No Air-conditioner Night, Earth Hour 2019, Fieldtrip to Kiu Tsui Geo Park (Co-Organised with the Department of Geography), Urban Biodiversity Search (Co-organised with WWF and Biology Society), Wetland Cleaning in Tai Po, visit to Yuen Long Fertilizer Composting Plant, Life-wide learning lessons (a Talk by Dr. Li Lok Sze and waste recycling), sharing in Morning Assemblies, training workshops, seminars, and. 3 Form four students participated in the "Geo Wonders Scheme" and they won the chance to go to China for the ecological trip in April. Also, 4 students participated the Movie Shooting Competition. Apart from these, our school joined the Student Environmental Protection Ambassador Scheme 2018-19 organized by the Education Bureau and the Environmental Protection Department, in which 19 Student Environmental Protection Ambassadors won Merit Awards and 13 students were awarded 'Basic Environmental Badge' and 9 students were awarded 'Specific Environmental Badge'. Three students were granted the "Outstanding Student Environmental Protection Ambassadors Awards", earning Gold and Silver Prizes. We also received great support from parents. Over 83% and 81 % families agreed to join the 'No Air Conditioner Night' and 'Earth Hour 2019' respectively. In short, the school year 2018-19 was fruitful and saw active participation from students and parents in environmental protection.

Aiming at fully exploring and developing the potentials of gifted students, the Gifted Education Team

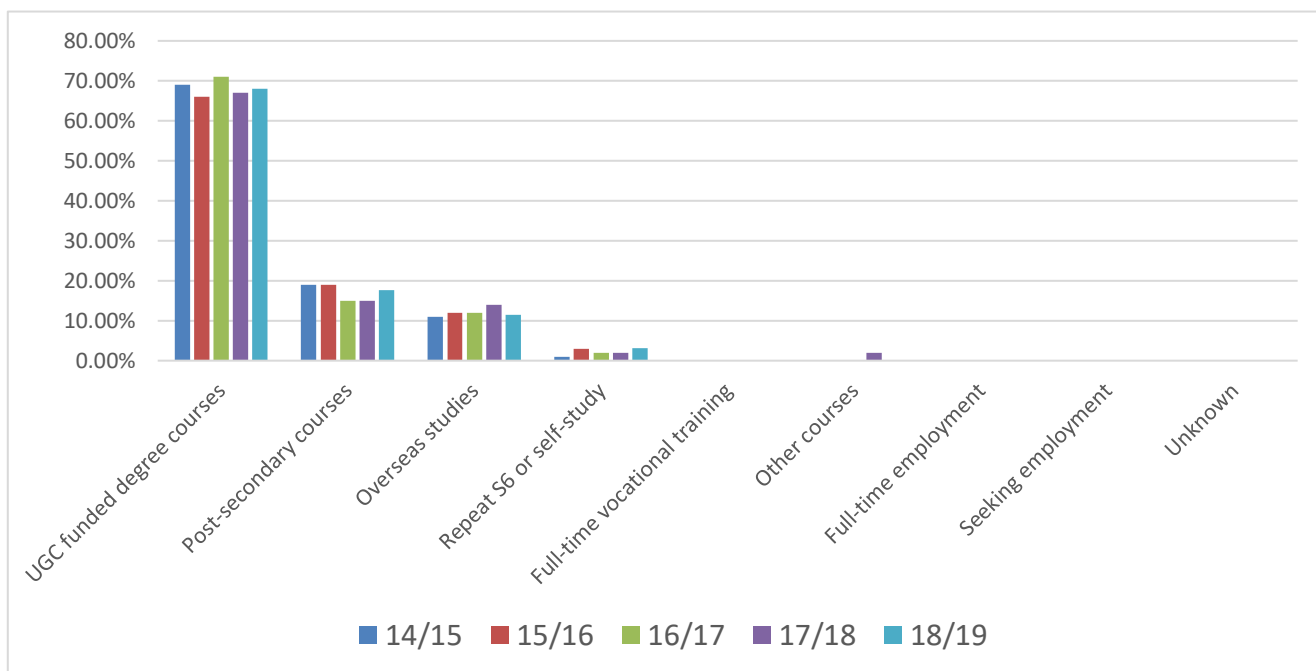
provided students with opportunities to receive education appropriate to their levels. In 2017-18, the Mathematics Department joined the Giftedness Into Flourishing Talent project offered by CUHK. In the project, our students applied the concept of Self-directed Learning and developed their higher-order thinking. Students not only developed their creativity, but also applied their knowledge in their daily lives. Moreover, the Team organized various training programmes including QC Mathematics Olympiad and QC Physics Olympiad. In addition, gifted students were invited to receive training to explore their thinking skills and creativity. Our school made contact with local tertiary institutes and provided regular programmes to our students, such as an airship-making workshop. Furthermore, to enhance our students' academic knowledge and practical skills, our school joined different competitions such as Gifted Angels — Services Learning Project 2017-18, 2018 Odyssey of the Mind World Finals and 2018 World GreenMech Contest.

The Leadership Development Team offered a range of activities for our students in 2017-18. In the adventure based Leadership Training Camp held in October, 2017, all (144) S4 students and 12 S5 leaders (Discipline and Counselling core prefects) were able to develop problem-solving abilities and teamwork through completing various tasks. The team also collaborated with the Counselling Team and held the S.1 Orienteering Competition in November 2017, in which all (144) S1 students, 47 S4 and S5 Counselling Prefects participated. The winning team of the competition further participated in the Eldpathy activity later in December 2017. In another collaboration with the Counselling Team in November 2017, 27 S4 and S5 Counselling Prefects were enrolled in the Adventure Ship Partnership Programme. In the programme, the prefects cooperated with mentally handicapped persons to complete tasks on a ship and developed their counselling and leadership skills. Moreover, 30 S2 students attended the 7-Habits Workshop, and 15 S4 and S5 students completed the negotiation and mediation workshop. In the Queen's College – Diocesan Girls' School exchange programme held in March 2018, 12 S4 students from each school participated in various activities including attending formal lessons and a leadership workshop. These activities were beneficial to the participants' personal development and thus they were able to make a positive impact on their peers.

Student Ambassadors aimed at promoting a strong school spirit and a sense of belonging among all students. They received training to familiarize themselves with school history and learned to introduce History Museum. They had a lot of experience on introducing school history to guests, visitors and their fellow schoolmates. They offered docent service in the following events and activities: History Museum Open Days, Dr SUN Yat-sen Museum Fun Day, guided tours to History Museum for S1 students, visits by Melbourne High School, Sir Ellis Kadoorie Primary School, Beijing 101 Middle School, etc. Two workshops were conducted to teach Student Ambassadors the skills of conducting oral history interviews. Students were also given opportunities to apply what they had learned by interviewing old boys.

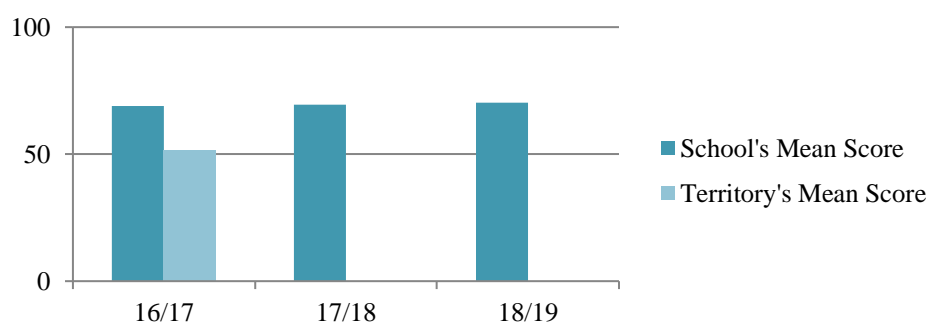

5.1 Destination of exit students

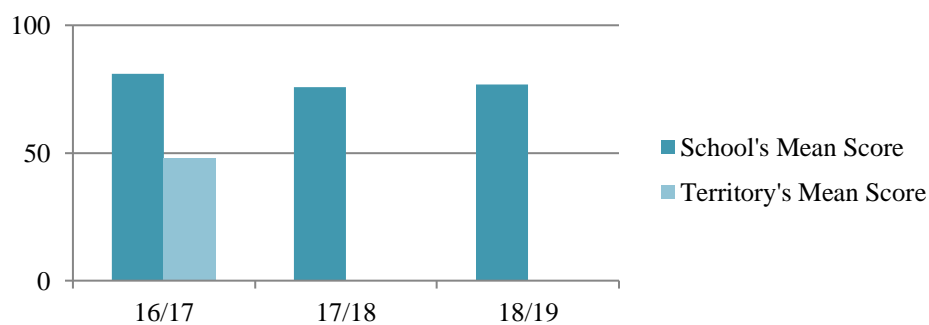


5.2 Results of Hong Kong Attainment Test (Pre-S1)

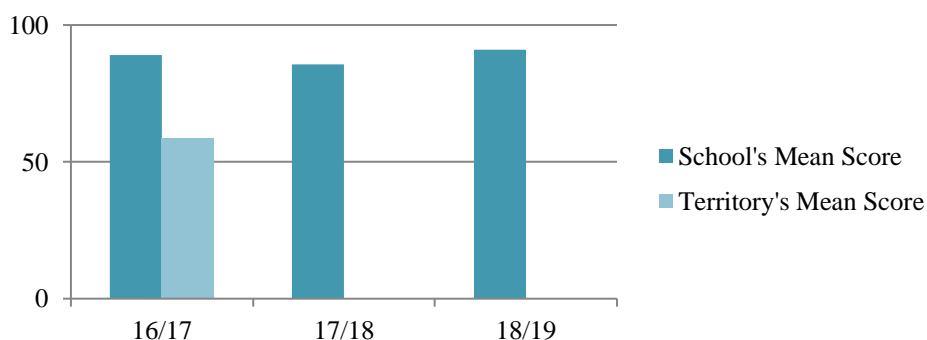
CHINESE (Pre-S1)
